How to take Action

Interact with Elected Officials:

1

Recognize that politicians really do track calls and emails. This is how they gauge the importance of an issue.

2

Make 5 calls or send 5 emails each day to elected representatives.

3

Nudge them to act from these common principles.

4

Ask them to take specific action on specific issues.

5

Connect regularly with a local group to build talking points and coordinate action.

Practice Dialogue

RECOGNIZE THAT:

Others are just as right as you are from their lens.

Standing on facts is not helpful when we are entrenched.

Listening and connection are what matter, by far.

PRACTICE TALKING TO YOUR NEIGHBOR:

Connect one on one.

Understand where someone stands. Step into their shoes.

Be curious about why they believe what they do.

Share your story.
